## Loitering Policy

Somerset County Library System defines loitering as: the act of entering and remaining in any area of the library (including but not limited to driveways, parking lot, steps, stoops, ramps, entrances, or other common areas) with no apparent purpose and without the apparent intent to use or examine the library facilities located in that area. Also, standing, sitting, lying anywhere on the premises in such a manner that sufficiently disturbs employees, or customers, or blocks or obstructs potential or actual traffic, obstructs use of the facilities, or inhibits employees or customers from executing their legitimate duties and activities. Longtime visiting or socializing on library premises disrupts the enjoyment of the library for other patrons and is not permitted.
